Under The Biden Administration, Defense Secretary Lloyd Austin Ordered A Day Long Stand Down To Discuss Domestic Violent Extremism, Which Was Criticized By Veterans. "Since 2020, the services have ramped up their diversity, equity and inclusion efforts, following a lead from then-Defense Secretary Mark Esper, who in the wake of George Floyd's murder called on the department to do better. Defense Secretary Lloyd Austin ran with that idea in the early weeks of the Biden administration, ordering a day-long stand down in every unit to discuss the threat of violent extremism, following years of proclamation from the FBI that right-wing domestic terrorism is on the rise. But to some, these efforts were a direct attack on their worldview. 'Instead of training and preparing for combat, today's military is too busy worrying about teaching proper pronouns, how to incorporate men who think they're women and women who think they're men into the barracks and showers,' wrote Ron Eslick, describing himself as a 1970s-era Navy submariner. '[Joint Chiefs Chairman] General Milley and Sec Def Austin are a disgrace to the uniform I once wore. They are nothing less than lap dogs to the current administration. In March 2021, Navy Admiral Gilday Confirmed That The Navy Recommended "How To Be An Antiracist" On A Navy Reading List Despite Congressional Concerns About Its Content Being "Anti-American" "Several Republican members of Congress voiced concerns about some of the books included on the Navy's 2021 reading list, but Adm. Michael Gilday said he is not making any changes. Rep. Jim Banks, R-Ind., who serves in the U.S. Navy Reserve as a Supply Corps officer and deployed to Afghanistan in 2014 and 2015, sent a letter to Gilday on Feb. 26 arguing that the views promoted in Ibram X. Kendi's 'How to Be an Antiracist' on the Chief of Naval Operations Professional Reading Program (CNO-PRP) are 'explicitly anti-American' and called on Gilday to explain the Navy's decision to include it on the reading list or remove it. Gilday responded to Banks in a March 12 letter obtained by Fox News saying he included Kendi's book on the CNO-PRP list because 'it evokes the author's own personal journey in understanding barriers to true inclusion, the deep nuances of racism and racial inequalities.' He added that he wants the Navy's sailors to achieve the same level of 'self-reflection.'" In view of recruiting problems, the 118th Congress should renew previous demands for information on woke policies.
