One of NewsGuard's biggest funders is the John S. and James L. Knight Foundation, a philanthropy that backs numerous left-wing causes, including a journalism department at Howard University headed by Nikole Hannah-Jones. Hannah-Jones is the author of the '1619 Project.' which pushes a distorted view of America's founding. Another NewsGuard backer is Jules Kroll, the founder of the intelligence firm that **helped Harvey** Weinstein compile dossiers on women who accused him of sexual assault."

### NewsGuard: Background, Timeline, and Controversies

#### Overview

NewsGuard is an internet news rating agency founded in 2018 with the aim of combating fake news by providing credibility ratings about news websites. Their service is free to readers through a browser extension and it makes money through software licensing agreements. Elon Musk has branded NewsGuard as a "scam" and a "propaganda shop."

An analysis has found that there is an "extraordinary left-wing bias" with NewsGuard's ratings. According to MRC Free Speech America, there is a 27-point disparity between its ratings of liberal news outlets compared to conservative outlets.

Numerous reviews of NewsGuard employees and company actions have found that the company is dominated by employees who have previously worked in Democrat circles, and its leadership has "predominately" contributed to the Democratic party. In January 2022, NewsGuard partnered with the American Federation of Teachers union.

Early funders of NewsGuard have backed "numerous left-wing causes." Including the John S. & James L. Knight Foundation, which has supported the Howard University journalism department headed by Nikole Hannah-Jones, the author of the "1619 Project" that advocates for an alternative view of America's founding.

Conservatives aren't the only political persuasion to take issue with NewsGuard's practices. In October 2023, the left-leaning Consortium for Independent Journalists filed suit in federal court alleging the company of "defamation" and "First Amendment violations" for defaming news organizations that question American foreign policy. The Consortium alleges these media organizations are labeled as "Anti-U.S." and purveyors of Russian "misinformation."

As a purveyor of Democratic news narratives, Americans can't trust NewsGuard to offer a fair-andbalanced review of the news and should be disbanded.





#### SUED FOR FIRST AMENDMENT VIOLATIONS
